### **BACHELOR'S DEGREE IN PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION: CONCENTRATION IN EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT**

Beginning in the Fall Semester, 2006, the Shaw University Department of Business and Public Administration will offer a new concentration in emergency management. Students who complete the program will earn a Bachelor's Degree in Public Administration with a Concentration in Emergency Management.

The program is designed to prepare students for management positions in agencies that provide varied emergency management-related services. The primary goals of the program are to increase the pool of culturally diverse emergency managers and to provide graduates with the educational background, knowledge, and experiences that enhance their ability to function successfully in the field of emergency management.

#### **General Information**

Courses will be offered online and via videoconferencing, as well as interactive classroom participation, primarily in the evening. Applicants to the program may apply as a freshman or as a transfer student. Students transferring from an accredited two-year institution may transfer no more than 70 credit hours and are required to complete at least 50 semester hours at Shaw University for the baccalaureate degree.

Enrollees will have the opportunity to take some of their classes at Shaw's College of Adult and Professional Education (CAPE) centers located in Ahoskie, Asheville, Durham, Fayetteville, High Point, Kannapolis, Raleigh, Rocky Mount/Greenville, and Wilmington.
